The Documents Association of New Jersey (DANJ) is offering two (2) travel grants to attend the Depository Library Council Meeting & Federal Depository Library Conference in Washington D.C. Each Grant will total \$300 and is meant to offset the travel and lodging expenses of conference attendance.

The grants are open to librarians, library staff members, and library school students who live in New Jersey, work in a New Jersey library, and/or attend an accredited library school (in person or online). Applications will be reviewed by a committee of DANJ Executive Board members.
